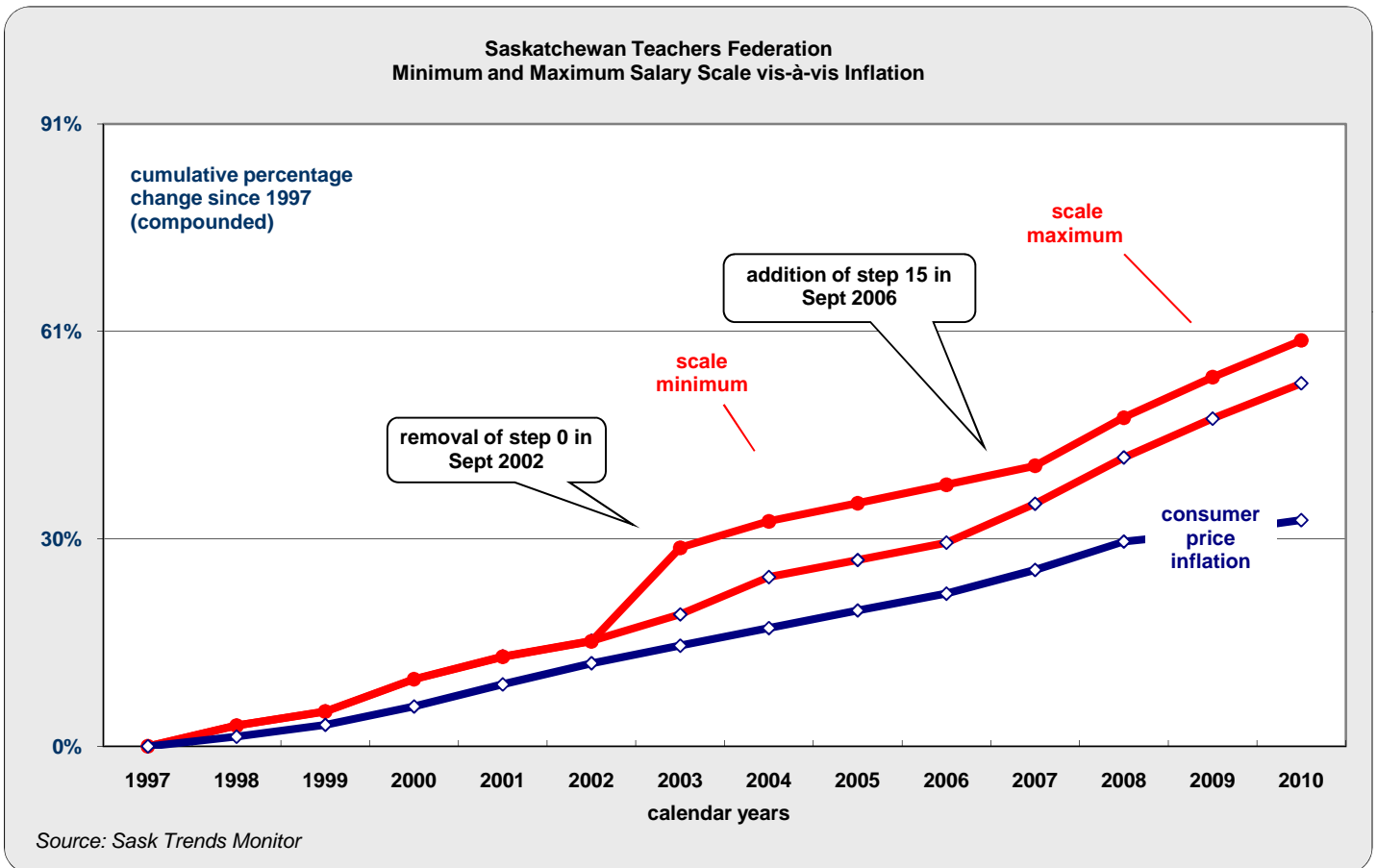

- * The figures do not take into account other monetary benefits such as signing bonuses, pension plan changes, compensation for preparation time, etc.
